


Full Broadcast (FB)

The highly slip resistant Degafloor Full Broadcast (FB) system offers an extremely hard wearing, textured finish suitable for wet, oily and contaminated areas. This rapid curing methyl methacrylate (MMA) industrial resin flooring is created through the broadcasting of quartz aggregate into a body coat which is then encapsulated by MMA seal coats. It has been specifically designed for areas that are regularly exposed to liquids and other contaminants that can cause slippery surfaces.

The FB system can be tailored, depending on your requirements, to deliver the ideal blend of safety, durability and ease of cleaning. Degafloor's FB system has become one of the most desirable commercial kitchen flooring choices as customers continue to seek solutions that deliver outstanding value and enhanced performance.





Quartz Trowelled (QT)

The Degafloor QT system delivers outstanding performance in the heaviest duty environments. The trowel applied system can be tailored to create a lightly textured or smooth finish and is ideal for areas such as corridors, bin stores, bars and dry stock rooms.

- 1. Final protective seal coat
- 2. Bodycoat mixed with quartz aggregate - trowel applied
- 3. Primer
- 4. Prepared substrate






Quartz Trowelled Aggregate (QTA)

The Degafloor QTA system is a highly textured version of the QT system, making it more practical for any wet areas or areas where slip resistance is a must. It is most suitable for application onto ramps or where falls need to be created.

- 1. Final protective seal coats
- 2. Aggregate broadcast
- 3. Bodycoat mixed with quartz aggregate - trowel applied
- 4. Primer
- 5. Prepared substrate





Attention to detail

– the key to longevity...

Successful floor installation and delivering long-term value is all about the detail. Many floor installations fail at the edges or where they join existing fixtures and finishes. All Degafloor systems are specifically designed to overcome these types of issues.

Coving/Skirting

Degafloor recommends that all floors within food & drink processing areas receive resin coving/skirting to a height of at least 100mm in a finish that matches the main floor. This coving/skirting will have a smooth finish and includes a curved radius so that there are no difficult to clean tight angles. This coving/skirting provides a continuous waterproof extension of the floor to protect the building structure during cleaning or should there be a major spill.

Floor Joints

Wherever possible, Degafloor systems are installed without any joints to create a totally seamless finish. However, should the substrate design dictate that joints are necessary, these are created using a flexible variant of the same resin type used to create the main floor area. This ensures that there is full chemical compatibility between the resins and that a very strong bond is created, allowing an ultra reliable finish to be maintained.

Abutments

Kitchen floors will often have drainage channels, gully pots and inspection chambers. All of these features create installation and performance challenges for many traditional flooring options. To overcome these types of issues, Degafloor has developed special additives that enable our primers to create an incredibly strong bond to metal surfaces. This ensures a joint free installation and delivers outstanding long-term performance.



Associated Products

Alongside our standard flooring systems, Degafloor offers a range of substrate repair solutions, installation tools and consumables to ensure that each and every project can be completed to the highest standard in the shortest time.

Within commercial kitchens projects, our repair solutions are used to overcome common problems that can arise prior to, and during, a flooring replacement project:
